A Global Policy Framework for Protection, Prevention, Healing, and Accountability

Global Policy Priority

The “Let’s Ensure Safe Spaces” campaign addresses systemic gaps in protection by establishing standardized, trauma-informed guidelines across workplaces, educational institutions, community hubs, and emergency humanitarian zones.

The IDG Healing Approach (Inner Development Goals)

Recognizing that physical safety must be complemented by psychological recovery, CDF integrates the Inner Development Goals (IDG) framework into survivor support networks.

1. Being & Presence

Cultivating self-awareness, emotional grounding, and inner stability following traumatic experiences.

2. Compassionate Relating

Restoring empathy, trust, and healthy community connections in supportive peer circles.

3. Action & Agency

Empowering survivors with confidence, leadership capacity, and active community decision-making.



5. CROSS-THEMATIC INTEGRATION

Embedding GBV Protection into Broader Sustainable Development Goals

GBV prevention cannot occur in isolation. CDF integrates protection principles into 8 primary thematic development sectors to address root vulnerabilities and ensure sustainable resilience.

\$ Women's Economic Empowerment

Connecting GBV protection with livelihood opportunities, skill acquisition, and financial autonomy to reduce economic dependence on abusers.

🌱 Food Security & Agriculture

Addressing risks faced by women smallholder farmers and ensuring safe access to agricultural assets and food distribution channels.

🏠 Climate Resilience & Preparedness

Mitigating heightened GBV risks during climate displacement through safe humanitarian distribution and crisis protocols.

💻 Digital Inclusion & Safety

Bridging the gender digital divide while providing robust digital safety education to mitigate cyberbullying and online exploitation.

Integrating respectful relationship modules into youth clubs and strengthening school-based safeguarding mechanisms.

Linking clinical response networks with community psychosocial support to ensure comprehensive survivor care.
